Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI)

Lakeview College of Nursing recognizes the ease in transferability with courses holding the IAI status. LCN requires RNs to complete the IAI core curriculum as follows:

Communication (9 cr.)	Take 2 sequenced courses in writing, plus 1 in speech. Examples follow:

Math (3 cr.)	Complete at least 1 math course that focuses on quantitative reasoning. Example follows:
