Lakeview requires 60 credit hours in general education and prerequisite courses. At least 45 credit hours must be complete at the time of application. It is necessary to fulfill the majority of this coursework at another institution and then transfer credit hours to Lakeview. Additional coursework may be required as some institutions may require prerequisites prior to enrolling in required courses listed below. Furthermore, due to varying credit hours for transfer courses, students may be required to complete additional coursework to fulfill the 60 credit hour general education requirements.

Please be advised there are financial aid implications if any of these courses are not successfully completed prior to beginning the nursing curriculum. If coursework is incomplete students will remain at sophomore status in consideration for student loans.
